RULES & REGULATIONS – applicable to all guests

- 1. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 for cabins and \$50 for sites is required at the time of booking. The 50% deposit is to be paid three months prior to arrival. The balance for the full period of booking is required upon arrival.
- 2. NO OPEN FIRES or FIREWORKS are permitted at any time unless authorised by the Park Manager.
- 3. No smoking in accommodation units or around food preparation areas a \$200 cleaning fee will be applied for smoking in cabins.
- 4. Persons causing damage to property, equipment, gardens and trees on Parks will be asked to leave the Park and may be prosecuted.
- 5. Washing of clothes and utensils in shower blocks is strictly prohibited. Clothes only are to be washed in laundry blocks.
- 6. Undue noise and bad language are not permitted at any time and no type of entertainment may disturb adjoining camps after 10.30pm or early in daylight hours. You may be asked to leave without a refund.
- 7. NO DOGS allowed in any of our accommodation units, we allow pets on powered and unpowered sites outside of school holidays and long weekends.
- 8. No permanent residents allowed and maximum continuous occupancy is limited to 149 days.
- 9. The number of caravans connected to electricity must not exceed the number of Donor outlets and 15-amp leads and plugs only to be used.
- 10. Children are not allowed to play in the amenities or laundry blocks.
- 11. Council and Seven Mile Beach Holiday Park accept no responsibility or liability for: Damage caused to, or theft of/from cabins, caravans, tents. Vehicles and trailers left on the Park or Damage caused to a caravan or its contents whilst being moved in the event of an emergency.
- 12. Allocation of sites is made by Park Management, however, due consideration will be given to arrange a site as requested or as near as possible thereto.
- 13. Push bikes must not be ridden after sunset. Push bikes, roller skates/blades and Skateboards are not to be ridden in or around the buildings. Speed limit must be adhered to and helmets to be worn at all times.

- 14. Children under the age of 7 years are not permitted in shower or toilet blocks unless accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 15. All gas bottles must comply with regulations, e.g. in date.
- 16. Children under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult. No bookings will be permitted for children under 18 years of age.
- 17. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children in the Park and are expected to supervise their behaviour.
- 18. Patrons are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- 19. The speed limit in the park is walking pace only (8kph).
- 20. Boom gate access codes are for use ONLY of the assigned vehicle registration. Tailgating additional vehicles through is strictly prohibited.
- 21. Parking is allocated to 1 vehicle per accommodation. Any additional vehicles are to be parked in the overflow carpark behind Reception.
- 22. A breach of any of the rules may result in guests being asked to leave the Park without a refund.
- 23. No refunds will be issued for early departure.
- 24. Check in time is 2pm. Check out time Monday Friday is 10am and check out time on Sunday is 4pm outside of school holidays.
- 25. Cabins are to be left clean and tidy. All cutlery, crockery, pots and pans etc are to be washed, dried and put away. Rubbish is to be put in the bin.
- 26. Cabins that are left untidy will be charged a cleaning fee of \$50.00 per hour.
- 27. Furniture is not to be re-arranged or moved from cabin to cabin.
- 28. All weekend bookings must include Friday and Saturday nights.
- 29. A minimum night's stay rule applies during high season.
- 30. Patrons are responsible for the conduct of their guests at all times and camp sites to be kept clean and tidy at all times and no clothes lines around sites.
