Pre-arrival declaration form

Bookings

To assist with physical distancing we request that you book online and make contactless payments.



Cleaning procedures

While we pride ourselves on maintaining high standards of cleaning year round, we have implemented additional procedures, including regular cleaning of high touch surfaces and communal areas.



Physical distancing

Ensure that you keep a distance of 1.5 metres between you and other park guests.



Shared areas

Many shared areas now have limits on maximum guests allowed in the area at any one time. If the area is at capacity, please be patient and wait until you can enter.



Outdoor Gatherings

Outdoor gatherings currently have restrictions on the maximum number of people allowed, please adhere to the government's rule and follow physical distancing.



Staff Training

All Park Managers have been trained in Safe Work Method practices for infection control.



Day Visitors

All day visitors must register with park reception before entering the park.

If you or your guests choose not to follow these safety measures or refuse to cooperate with park management and staff you may be asked to leave the property.
